Key Projects (continued)

- **Groundwater and Soil Assessment of a Large and Complex Manufacturing Company, NJ**—Evaluated source area contaminations at a 669-acre facility with a portion of the site still occupied by an active production facility. Horizontal and vertical delineation of contamination by single point compliance in groundwater and soils.
